To check what safety equipment is required for your vessel in Smooth, Sheltered or Coastal Waters, see the Equipment table.

- Sheltered waters are all waters not exceeding 2 nautical miles to seaward of land on the north and east coasts, unless otherwise specified in the MAST "Operational Areas" information sheet.
- Coastal waters are those beyond sheltered waters as well as waters on the west and south coasts between Cape Grim and South East Cape
