MARINE AND SAFETY (PRESCRIBED OFFENCES) BY-LAWS 2023

The Marine and Safety Authority makes the following by-laws under section 42 of the *Marine and Safety Authority Act 1997*.

1. Short title

These by-laws may be cited as the *Marine and Safety (Prescribed Offences) By-laws 2023*.

2. Commencement

These by-laws take effect on 1 July 2023.

3. Prescribed offences

- (1) For section 45(1) of the *Marine and Safety Authority Act 1997*, an offence against a provision of the respective by-laws specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to these by-laws is a prescribed offence.
- (2) The penalty specified in column 2 of that Schedule opposite that provision is the penalty payable under an infringement notice served in respect of that offence.

4. Rescission

The *Marine and Safety (Prescribed Offences) By-laws 2013* are rescinded.
